**3. PROGRESS REPORTS**

Attached for the Committee’s review are copies of the Progress Reports for those programs utilizing Community Development Block Grant and HOME Funds. All figures indicate the progress made and services rendered to date for FY 2011-2012.

- Community Services - Case Management
  - 366 Case Management clients were served.
  - 87 Volunteer Hours of assistance were donated to the program.
  
- Youth Diversion Program
  - 4 Participants were served by the program.
  
- Management Services - Code Enforcement
  - The Code Enforcement Division investigated a total of 1507 complaints.
  - 240 were in areas identified as in low- to moderate-income areas.
  - Code Enforcement staff referred 2 to the Housing Department programs.
  
- Development Services - Fair Housing
  - The Housing Rights Center served 259 clients.
  - A variety of issues were discussed, including: evictions, security deposits, rent increases, repairs, contract questions, etc.
  
- Development Services - Housing Programs
  - First-Time Home Buyer - HOME: 7 searching for a home, 5 escrows closed.
  - HOME Major Rehabilitation: 4 in process, 7 completed.
  - CDBG Minor Rehabilitation: 1 in process, 2 completed.
