3. Approval of the Minutes of July 14, 2010

4. Safety and Stop Sign Review – Chapel Avenue and Elgin Street

Staff will review the report that was prepared in response to a citizen request for a review of the intersection of Chapel Avenue and Elgin Street. Presently there is an unprotected crosswalk across Chapel Avenue.

Recommended Action

It is recommended that the Transportation Commission review the report with the City Engineer, listen to public comment and authorize staff to implement the additional safety measures as outlined in the report.

5. Safety Report - Pepper Street at Raymond Avenue

Staff will review the report that was prepared in response to a citizen request received for stop signs on Pepper Street at Raymond Avenue. The study concluded that stop controls and stop bars can be placed on Pepper Street at its intersection with Raymond Avenue. To improve sight visibility, the report recommends 20 feet of red curb at the southwest corner of this intersection.

Recommended Action

It is recommended that the Transportation Commission review the report with the City Engineer, listen to public comment and authorize staff to implement the additional safety measures as outlined in the report. Further it is recommended that the Transportation Commission recommend approval to the City Council for the installation of stop controls on Pepper (east and west approaches) at its intersection with Raymond Avenue.

6. Request for All-Way Stop at the Intersection of Palm Avenue and Larch Street

Staff will review the report that was prepared in response to a citizen request received for an all way stop control at the intersection of Palm Avenue and Larch Street. The study concluded that an all way stop control at this intersection is not warranted at this time. In order to increase sight distance, it is recommended to install red curbing for a length of 60 feet on the east side of Palm Avenue approaching the crosswalk. In addition, it is recommended that the street legends be repainted and signage be replaced, as outlined in the report.

Recommended Action

It is recommended that the Transportation Commission review the report with the City Engineer, listen to public comment and authorize staff to implement the additional safety measures as outlined in the report.
