TO REGISTER – It's easy to register. You can Phone-In, Fax, Drop-Off, or Mail-In your registration. Please refer to the registration form in the back of the brochure, for the correct address or telephone number for registration. Participants will be allowed to register in class at the first class meeting, as space permits. Participants will not be admitted to any fee program without being registered or paying the guest fee. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. All classes are subject to cancellation or schedule change if class minimums are not met. Classes are closed when maximum enrollment is met and/or after the third week of each session. Enroll early to ensure the minimum for the class you desire has been met. Children are not allowed in adult classes with parents.

PAYMENT – Payments can be made with cash (exact amount only), MasterCard, Visa, Discover, personal check or money order. When paying by check please include your driver's license number and expiration date on the check. All fees are payable in full at the time of registration and are not transferable or prorated. In-class registration is taken the first day of class only. Payments can be made with MasterCard, Visa, Discover, personal check or money order. NO CASH will be accepted by city staff for in-class registration.

GUESTS – Guests are invited to attend class for a one-time guest fee, only within the first three weeks of class. A \$7 guest fee must be paid by check, payable to the City of Alhambra. If you decide to register for the class, the \$7 guest fee will be applied toward the registration fee, otherwise it is forfeited.

REFUND AND CANCELLATION POLICY – The City of Alhambra will not issue any refunds after the first class meeting. Refunds will only be granted if the participant cancels prior to the first class meeting. A \$2 processing fee will be assessed. 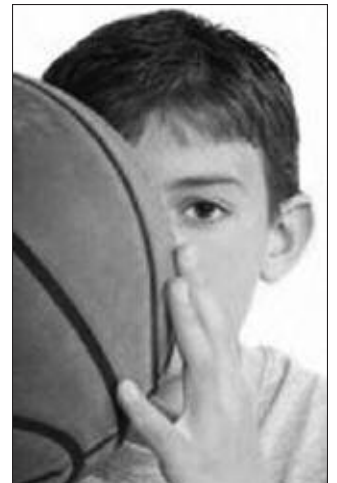

CASE MANAGEMENT PROJECT SERVICES

Case Management Services include a comprehensive assessment of the client, care plan for services, and monthly telephone contact to monitor and modify services as needed. Services may include:

HOMEMAKER SERVICES

Staff will coordinate in-home assistance in the form of meal preparation, basic household tasks, and light cleaning.

PERSONAL CARE SERVICES

Staff will coordinate assistance to frail clients to maintain personal hygiene, personal safety and maintain activities of daily living.

IN-HOME RESPITE SERVICES

Staff will coordinate temporary assistance to a client in the absence of their current caregiver.

OUTREACH SERVICES

Staff will identify potential clients and encourage their use of existing services. This is done on a one-on-one basis or in a group presentation.

REGISTRY SERVICES

A list of service providers is available for seniors who are in need of a little assistance in order to remain at home independently. All service providers on the list are screened and fingerprinted. Services and the compensation rate are negotiated between client and provider. It is the clients responsibility to pay the service provider.

TELEPHONE REASSURANCE

Case Management Project senior volunteers make weekly telephone calls to homebound seniors to check on their safety, well-being, and provide contact with the outside world.

NUTRITION REFERRALS

Staff can provide information about Home Delivered Meals, Congregate Meals, and Food Banks.

TRANSPORTATION

Staff can provide assistance with Senior Ride appointments, Access Services registration, and local public transit information.

ASSISTIVE EQUIPMENT

Staff can arrange to have a loan of equipment such as walkers, commodes, cane, and wheelchairs delivered to your home.

HOUSING REFERRALS

Staff can provide Housing Lists and Assistance with placement.

Staff can assist with Social Security issues, Advocacy for Seniors, and Consultations.

For emergencies, (i.e. doctor's appointment), you may call the same day for a ride. Every effort will be made to accommodate your needs and to arrive as near as possible to your chosen time however, rides are not guaranteed.

MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

Always have priority. On occasion, you may be asked to re-schedule your social or shopping appointment because someone has an emergency medical appointment. We will do the same for you, should you have a medical emergency.

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

If you require special assistance, please let us know when you make your reservation. Although all vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts, we need to schedule adequate time to accommodate your needs. If you are physically disabled or frail, and need assistance to board the vehicle, you may bring an "escort" to assist you. Drivers cannot act as your escort to or from any building. When you make your reservations, notify the dispatcher that you need two seats. Companions will not be allowed to ride unless they are either eligible for Senior Ride or are serving as an "escort."

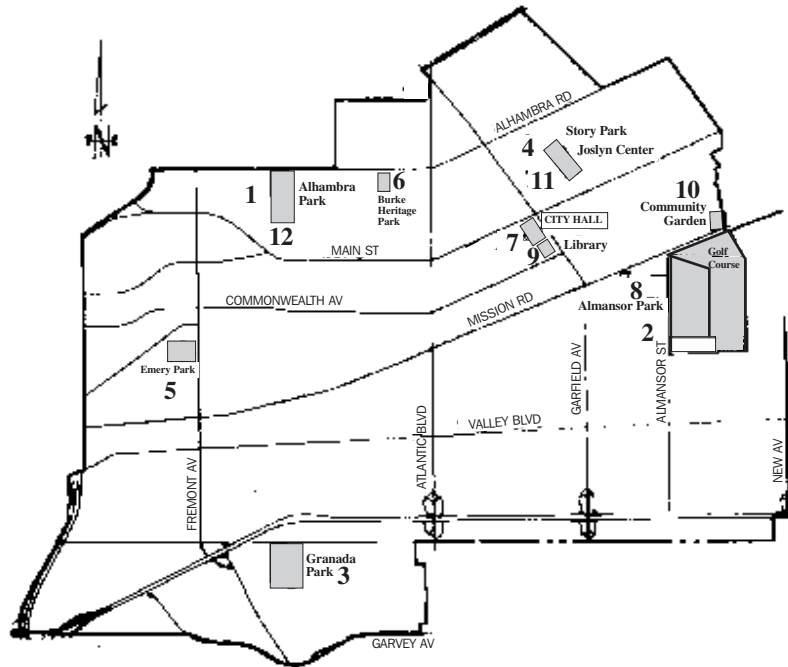
