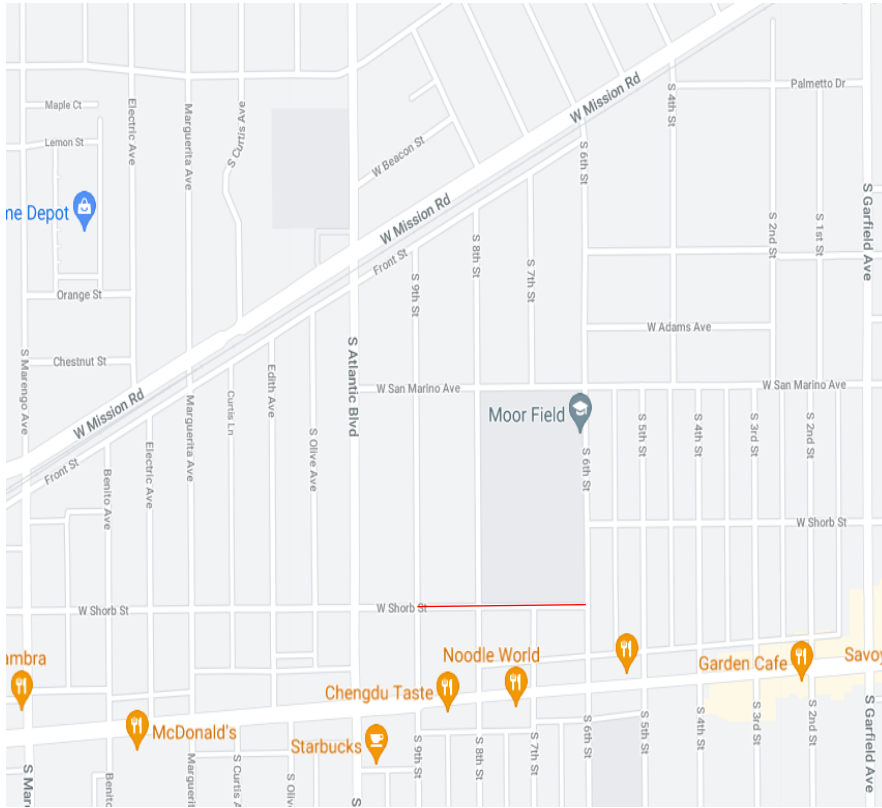


# NOTICE OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

This notice is to advise you that the City of Alhambra has awarded a contract to Sully-Miller Contracting Co. for the construction of the FY19-20 SB1 Street Rehabilitation Project. This project includes the pavement rehabilitation of the following streets:

- Shorb (from 9<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>)



Weather permitting and any other potential delay, construction activity and partial street closures have been scheduled.

## **Friday August 20th**

We will make every effort to allow as much access as possible during construction. During the paving of the streets, there will be no access all traffic will be detoured to alternative routes at the end of every shift you will have access to your driveway and street. **Construction Hours 7am to 5pm.**

We thank you for your cooperation during construction and assure you we will move through the project as efficiently as possible to minimize any inconvenience.

## **\*\*Frequently Asked Questions\*\***

**Q. Will trash still be collected during construction?**

**A. YES.** Sully Miller Contracting Co., the City of Alhambra and Republic Services are working together to ensure your services are not interrupted.

**Q. Will I have access to my driveway/parking/garage facing the street that's in construction?**

**A. No driveway, parking and garage access will be available *during construction hours (7AM – 5PM)*.** You will notice temporary “No Parking” signs along the street with certain timeframes. Street Sweeping parking restrictions will be relaxed during construction in the surrounding streets. You will be able to park in cross-streets and nearby streets if you are worried about not being able to get out of your parking during **construction hours (7AM TO 5PM)**.

**Q. Will closures be up through the week?**

**A. Closures will only be during construction. At the end of every day, the contractor will clear out the street until the following morning when work starts again. **Construction working hours are 7AM to 5PM.****
